



Pre-Treatment for Laser Hair Removal

Face- 4 weeks

Underarm & Bikini- 6 weeks

Legs- 8 weeks

- * No sun exposure for a minimum of 3 weeks prior or after treatment to area being treated
 - * No waxing, tweezing or threading 4 – 6 weeks prior to treatment
 - * Shave area before treatment 2-3 days in advance
 - * No bleaching (hair being treated)
 - * No antibiotics 2 weeks prior to treatment
 - * No Accutane. Must be off of medicine for minimum of 6 months
 - * No retin-A for 1 month before LHR on face
 - * If a Dr. prescribes any new medications check to see if they can cause photo sensitivity
 - * We ask that you shave the area to be treated 3 days before your appointment. If this is not completed, the first time we will trim the area for you complementary. After the first incident there will be a charge of \$25 for each area the staff has to shave. Shaving takes our staff's time and may cause a longer appointment to be scheduled.
- *** Need medical clearance prior to treatment for Lap Band, By-pass, Pace Makers, Diabetes, Pregnancy, nursing mothers, any medical condition if under a physicians care.

If you have blonde, light gray, and red hair, you may not be a good candidate for laser hair removal.
